



Situated in the historic fishing port of Provincetown at the tip of Cape Cod, Seashore Point (formerly Cape End Care Campus) will provide continuing care to the Cape's outermost senior community.

Located within the Provincetown Historic District, Seashore Point reflects elements typical to the Cape Cod coastal vernacular: steep roof lines with dormers, wood shingles, widow's walks and cupolas, yet maintains the residential scale of the surrounding neighborhood. Working within a tight site, the design allows for open landscaped courts that will connect with adjacent town recreational areas.

The proposed program includes 81 independent living apartments, 41 beds of skilled nursing (which will replace an outdated facility owned by the Town) and outpatient rehab services. Because the site is carefully located within this unique community the common areas are located on the upper floors to take advantage of available views.
